We apply this philosophy throughout the recovery process and within our residential substance abuse facilities. Clients experience a supportive environment and comprehensive services that meet their unique needs, provide clear life direction and enable a new lifestyle of work and independence.

The Gándara Addiction Recovery Program (GARP) offers treatment and life training services specifically for Spanish-speaking men.

Serenity House's year-long women's housing in Chicopee focuses on life and job skills training as well as health advocacy.

Miracle House supports single adults in recovery and people living with HIV in a low-income subsidized facility in Springfield.

GRSW Residential Services for Women facilitates reintroduction into the community for women who are part of the Criminal Justice and DSS systems or the DMH and includes pregnant women and new mothers.

Supportive Case Management for Community Housing provides permanent housing for families affected by substance abuse allowing clients and their families to recover together with comprehensive treatment and support services.
